Aims & Objectives



- To provide exposure to a variety of sport and recreation experiences.
- To encourage planning at all levels of administration.
- To provide a cost effective opportunity for rural and remote areas to access coaching, officials and sports administration education.
- To provide a cost effective opportunity for teachers in rural and remote areas to access inservice programs.
- To provide specialist squad training opportunities outside those normally available in the rural and remote areas.
- To provide a forum that encourages open communication between peak sporting bodies and their affiliates.
- To provide an opportunity for the development of mutually beneficial relationships between peak sporting organisations and their affiliates.
- To provide a forum that encourages open communication and the sharing of information between all stakeholders.

These guidelines have been developed to assist sports and development officers in preparing for the North Queensland Sports Education Tours. If you have any queries or concerns please do not hesitate in contacting the North Queensland Sports Foundation.

Community Clinics Sports should contact their respective sports in each of the centres visited to establish their requirements. The Foundation is happy to help with contacts and information about individual sports and facilitates available for that sport in each centre.

School Clinics The foundation contacts schools in each area and organises the programs. Schools are requested to divide groups into approximate 25 students of a like age. The area visited range from areas with small schools of 40 to 50 children to schools 150 children. Some schools are for pre-school to Year 12. In most centres school programs will have a diverse range of ages catering for all the children from the area. This means that Development Officers will need to be prepared to offer clinics to all age groups.

Equipment Sports equipment should be organised so that it is packed and easily accessible and can be set up in a short period of time (less than ½ Hour).

Travel All travel is ex Townsville/Cairns and includes all travel expenses on the tour. Members of the tour party share driving. The tour co-ordinator has a BP card for refuelling vehicles.

Meals All meals are provided on the tour. Drinks in the evening are the responsibility of the Development Officers.

Water The Foundation does provide water and ice in an esky for the Development Officers while they are conducting clinics. However the Development Officers are asked to provide their own drinks at other times.

Luggage Please keep personal luggage to the minimum.

PLEASE NOTE: All rental vehicles should be refuelled prior to returning to the rental company. (Avis charge a refuelling cost if cars are not full on return)

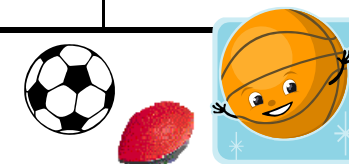
