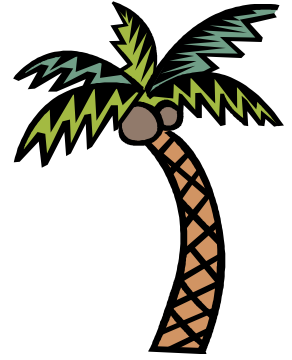

## **Migi Carnival 2011 Game Rules**

1. No Use Of Feet
2. No Raised Stick
3. No Raised Ball (Below knee height)
4. 5 yard Rule \*
5. Tap n Go \*
6. No Stick on stick
7. No Pushing or shoving players
8. Be respectful to umpires, coaches and all players

\* 5 yard Rule – When a free hit is awarded the opposing players must be 5 yards back from the ball when the player taking the free hit.

\* Tap n Go – When a player is awarded a free hit he does not have to pass the ball to a team mate to start the game as he can choose to tap the ball to himself and go

1. 6 field players and 1 goalkeeper on the field at 1 time, each team may have reserves
2. To score a goal player must shoot from inside the circle.
3. Games will be 12 minutes per half, 6 minute half time.

### **Other Rules**

1. Stay with your supervisor, coach and teacher.
2. Listen to and follow instructions from adults.
3. Do not disturb Horn Island Campus classes.
4. Get permission to leave the area to go to the toilet.
5. Keep your area tidy and leave it tidy at the end of the day.

Remote and Indigenous Hockey together with our partners Tagai State College and TSYRA are all committed to provide on-going opportunities to young people across the Torres Strait Island Communities.

Hockey is an equal opportunity sport and one that can be played for Life all over the world.

Remote and Indigenous Hockey can provide pathways from Migi Kokan to opportunities to play regional and state competition or to be selected as coaches/umpires/officials to regional and state championships.

From the State Championships, there is opportunity if selected to represent Queensland and be identified for national programs which ultimately lead to playing in the Olympics and World Cup for Australia.

Many of our current Queensland players representing Australia began their hockey in small regional associations such as Rockhampton, Mackay and Warwick.

In 2011 we will be selecting 9 players from Migi Kokan to undertake additional specialist hockey training and in 2012 these players will have the opportunity of travelling to Cairns to play on international quality hockey pitch and work with Cairns specialized coaches as well as play games against Cairns regional teams. These players will then be considered for selection in FNQ regional teams to contest the state championships in Jun 2012.

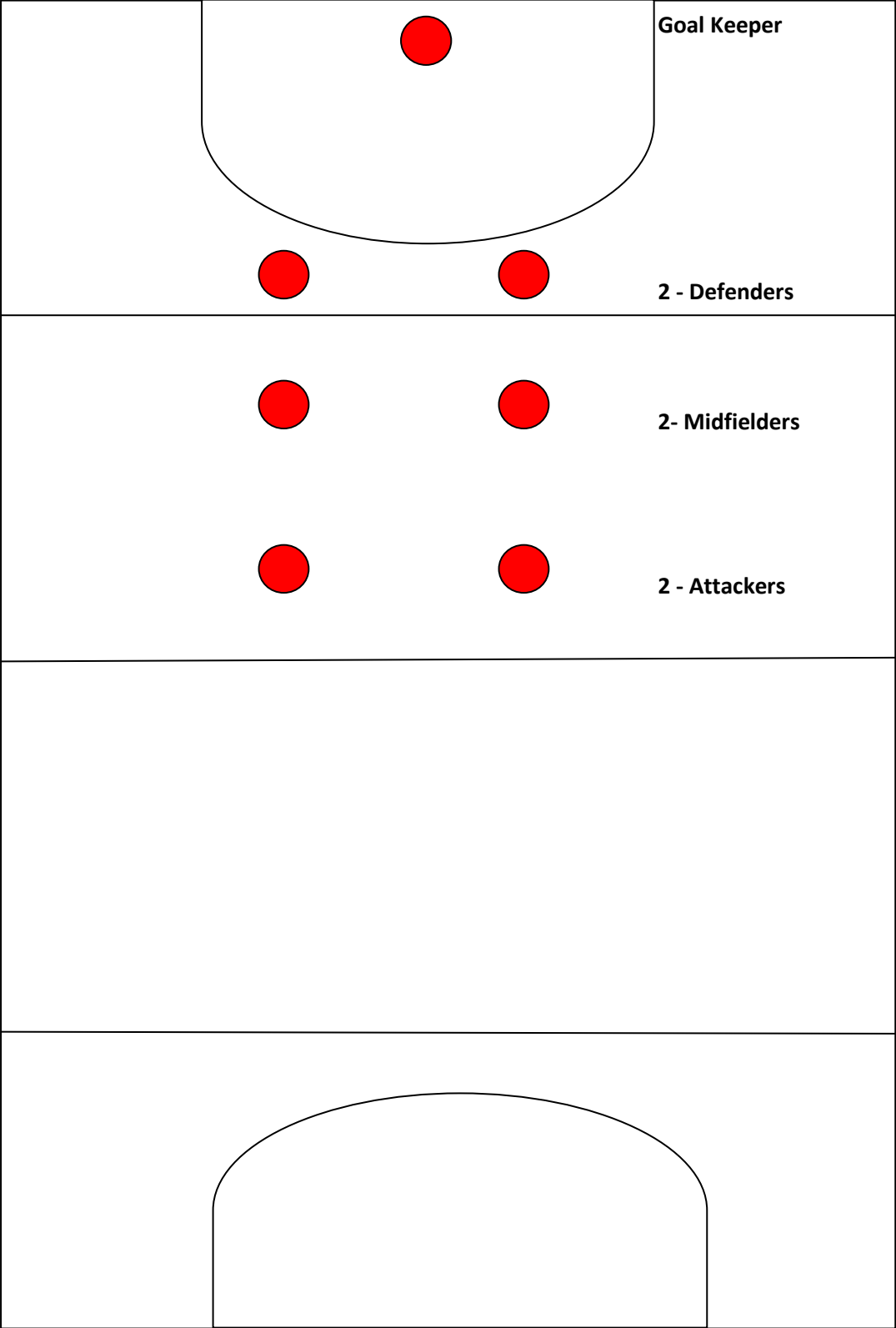
