1. Thursday will be competition day.
2. The games will be 8 a side on a whole field.
3. Unlimited interchanges
4. 15 minute games - no half time
5. 4 points for a win
2 points for a draw
1 point for loss
6. After the round robin games - teams ranked 1 -v- 2 will play off in the final.
7. There will be 2 umpires on the pitch and we will have one person from the remote program and one person from a centre not involved in the game.
This way we can introduce an element of umpire/officiating development across the competition.
8. The RCD at Cairns Hockey will be available for coaches to talk and coach support is available.
9. Hockey Queensland will be providing a trophy for the winning team and individuals will receive winners medallions.
10. All participants will receive a specially designed medal for being involved.
